		1	All apparatus shall meet Maryland Department of Transportation Standards – lighting, axle loads, tire size, frame capacities, height, length, width, etc. Annual DOT inspection paperwork shall be carried on the apparatus.
		2	Shall be equipped with the appropriate emergency vehicle warning devices required by the Maryland Motor Vehicle Code, including functional emergency warning lights and emergency audible warning devices.
		3	(2) or more-wheel chocks, mounted or stored in readily accessible locations
		4	(1) Traffic vest for each seating position, to comply with ANSI/ISEA 207 and have a five-point breakaway feature.
		5	(4) Traffic control devices (ie: flares, cones, etc.)
		6	(1) Allegany County Mobile Radio provided by DES
		7	4 Wheel Drive
		8	The apparatus shall be equipped with a fire pump that has a minimum rated capacity of 50 GPM.
		9	The unit shall be equipped with a water tank that has a minimum certified capacity of 150 gallons.
		10	(1) 10-B:C Extinguisher minimum
		11	(1) 150 ft of ½ inch or larger fire hose with combination nozzle
		12	(1) Pulaski
		13	(2) Brush Rakes
